Summer Camp Weeks

#1 Marine Biologists June 4 – June 8

Your junior Marine Biologists will enjoy a fun filled beach week right here on our campus. Campers will take a close look at Florida Sea Life and have lots of fun digging for shark's teeth. We will learn to differentiate between fresh and salt water habitats and will observe, compare, and contrast the characteristics of several species while creating a sea life diorama to bring home at the end of the week.

#2 Kitchen Chemists June 11 – June 15

Slice, dice, mix, and measure! Our Kitchen Chemists will have fun working on their cooking skills by prepping and preparing healthy food. Campers will measure wet and dry ingredients and enjoy the chemistry that takes place when we mix ingredients together. Children will create individual cookbooks to share recipes with family and friends, and each child will bring home their own custom designed chef's hat. Bon-Appetit!

#3 Animal Planet June 18 – June 22

Our young animal enthusiasts will learn about animals that are furry, crawl, walk, and leap. Campers will enjoy an in-house field trip from animal friends, build their own animal habitats, and journal discoveries.

#4 Sports Mania June 25 – June 29

We will focus on cooperative games including baseball, soccer, and parachute play emphasizing the importance of teamwork and sportsmanship as we emerge our campers in everything sports. We will learn about contemporary athletes and sports history and discover the engineering of obstacle courses!

#5 Sensational Science July 9 – July 13

Every successful adult was once a curious child! Will it freeze, explode, or evaporate? Campers will learn about earth science from static electricity to volcanoes, and participate in experiments, form hypotheses and investigate outcomes.

#6 Music Makers July 16– July 20

Campers will have their own musical passport and travel documents. We will sing songs, play games, make and play instruments, dance, and march to the beat as we explore music from all around the world.

#7 Space Explorers July 23 – July 27

Through hands on experiments we will learn all about space travel and the laws of gravity. Campers will construct model spaceships and we will finish the week with a visit from Buzz Lightyear and Woody!
